Mr Upali Amarasiri has retired from NILIS, University of Colombo on 23.02.2014 after serving two terms as the Director from 2008 February. Introduction of new courses in Information Management, Archival Science, ICT, extending postgraduate education facilities to SLLA Diploma and Associateship holder and Kelaniya University LIS Higher

Diploma holders and senior working librarians, attracting foreign students and students from the private sector, improving infrastructure facilities, collaboration with foreign universities, introduction of CONL is, NILIS consultancy services project in LIS field, laying foundation for degree programmes in LIS, Information Management and information Audit fields, initiating the NILIS annual research symposium are some of the major achievements of NILIS during Mr Amarasiri's tenure. Mr Amarasiri also served as the President/SLLA from 2009 to 2012 and successfully conducted the golden jubilee celebrations of the SLLA in 2010 with participation of the President/IFLA and the Presidents of the Library Associations of SAARC Countries. He was also instrumental in introducing an official attire/cloak for the SLLA members and also launching the Vijita de Silva Research Fellowship of SLLA. Mr Amarasiri earlier served as the 3rd Director/Director General of NLDSB (1989-2008) and also as the founder National Librarian (1990-2008) of the country.

New Director of the National Institute of Library and Information Sciences (NILIS) University of Colombo



Mr. Prasanna Ranaweera has been appointed as the new Director of the National Institute of Library and Information Sciences, (NILIS) University of Colombo, Sri Lanka. Before appointment to the present post, Mr. Ranaweera was employed as a Senior Lecturer at the same Institute. Prior to joining NILIS, he was employed as an Asst Librarian at the

University of Sri Jayewardenepura and at the National Library of Sri Lanka, which has enabled him to gain 22 years of professional experience in the field. His research interests are in the areas of information literacy skills among the University students, and Information center management. He has published several Journal Articles and presented a large number of conference papers locally and internationally. His academic background includes B.A. (Hons), Master of Arts, and Masters in Library and Information Sciences, while also being a PhD scholar. He is a qualified university lecturer, having successfully completed the Certificate of Teaching in Higher Education, and also holds the Diploma in Advanced English for Administration and Academic Purposes from the University of Colombo.

Mr N Amarasinghe, former Director, Sri Lanka National Library Services Board (SLNLSB), (present NLDSB) and the founder Head, Department of Library and Information Science, University of Kelaniya, passed away in August 2013. Mr Amarasinghe joined the public service as an Assistant Archivist at the Department of National Archives. Later he served at the Junior University College in Dehiwala and Peradeniya University library. Mr Amarasinghe joined SLNLSB in 1976 as the second Director of the organization and served till 1988. He served as the Education Officer and a lecturer of SLLA for a long time. After leaving the SLNLSB he joined the University of Papua New Guinea. With his demise Sri Lanka lost a pioneering bibliographer, excellent teacher in the Library and Information Science (LIS) field and a quality librarian.
